The **Children's Mystery Walk** starts at **Friends House**, opposite Euston station, and ends at the **Imperial War Museum** in Lambeth. It takes in many sites of special *peace* interest through Central London, including statues, monuments, memorials, famous buildings, gardens and other places with an important connection to London's peace heritage.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

It is primarily for young people aged **5 to 11**, however older siblings are sure to have fun too, a great day out for everyone! Children are given a **Mystery Walk puzzle book** and a special **Mystery Walk passport**. They find clues, solve puzzles and decode messages along the route in order to get their passports stamped at each site, all the while learning about important moments from the history of peace. There are different levels of puzzle for different ages and abilities, and **Mystery Walk stewards and guides** will be at each site to help, and stamp passports when tasks have been completed.

Registration on the day will start at **12pm** at **Friends House, 173 Euston Road, NW1.** People wi'll set off in small groups once they have registered and received their puzzle books, passports, map and instructions. Groups will cover the route at their own pace – this is not a race! The walk is about 4 miles, which can easily be done in the time available. There are also short cuts and buses if you get tired. Bring a packed lunch.

HOW DO I JOIN?
